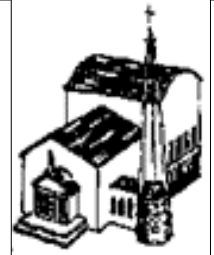

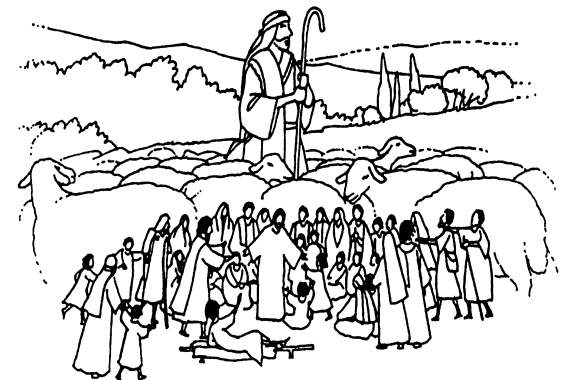
We pray for Pope Leo XIV

XIV. A 69 years old native of Chicago who has spent much of this life as an Augustinian missionary in Peru and has worked in the Vatican. We thank God and pray for him.

The Mass readings for the 4th Sunday of Easter Year C (Good Shepherd Sunday) highlight the themes of Jesus as the Good Shepherd, the importance of listening to God's voice, the inclusivity of God's love for all nations, the significance of interfaith relationships, and the manner in which we worship God. The readings demonstrate that Jesus calls people from all backgrounds to follow him, emphasizing the unity and diversity of God's flock.
