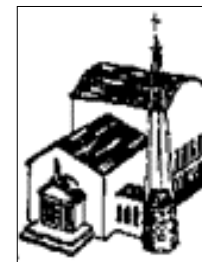

ALL SAINTS: 2nd November 2025



In the Gospel today Jesus offers to us the beatitudes - the blue-print for the life of a saint.

We are a church of saints and sinners - all called to be saints. Last Sunday in Rome Pope Leo gave us a wonderful

picture of what the church must be: "We must dream of and build a more humble Church; a Church that does not stand upright like the Pharisee, triumphant and inflated with pride, but bends down to wash the feet of humanity; a Church that does not judge as the Pharisee does the tax collector, but becomes a welcoming place for all; a Church that does not close in on itself, but remains attentive to God so that it can similarly listen to everyone. Let us commit ourselves to building a Church that is entirely synodal, ministerial and attracted to Christ and therefore committed to serving the world."



November Month of the Holy Souls: we remember and pray for the dead, those we have known and loved and those who have no one to pray for them. At every Mass the faithful departed are remembered.

Monday 3rd November: Feast of All Souls - Mass at 10.00am. There will be a special Mass at 7.00pm in St Mary's Aughton that evening. It will be a Mass for All Souls but it will also include the jubilee indulgence and the jubilee icon. As you know St Mary's Shrine is designated as a jubilee church for the Holy Year.
